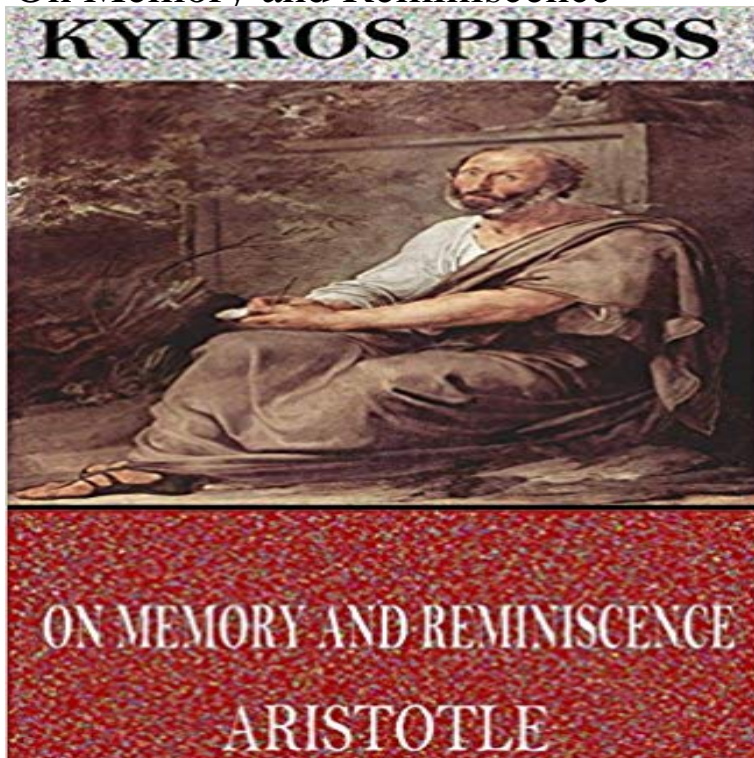


On Memory and Reminiscence
